We are accepting applications for camping spaces from the general public on a first come/first serve basis. We purchased all available camping sites from the park and are pleased to let you know that we will rent these spaces for the exact amount we paid the park for them. Spaces are \$50 for a packaged deal of Friday/Saturday night, plus \$20 entry fee per person camping at the site for the festival entry (youth ages 12 and under are free). Wristbands must be worn on the grounds during Saturday and Sunday. Wristbands will be mailed to you 10 days before the festival. Elizabeth Lions will not be responsible for lost prepaid wristbands. RULES

No person or vehicle shall enter any areas or use facilities for which fees are prescribed without payment.

You must be 18 years or older to rent a campsite.

Any person operating a motorized vehicle must be at least 16 years old. No motorized vehicles are allowed on walking trails. ALL MOTORIZED VEHICLES MUST YIELD TO PEDESTRIANS AT ALL TIMES.

Only two vehicles, including camper vehicle, allowed per campsite.

The carrying, possession, or discharge of firearms, air/gas powered weapons or fireworks are prohibited.

All park speed limits must be obeyed.

Trash, waste, garbage, or refuse including gray water discharge, shall not be thrown, scattered, or left upon the ground or discharged into any body of water. Each campsite must be kept in a clean and orderly manner. Please use trash receptacles provided in the park. A dump station is available, see Toll House attendant for use.

All pets must be kept on a leash and must be attended to at all times.

Camping shall be in designated areas only.

There is a maximum limit of six persons per campsite.

Each campsite is limited to two camping units per site (i.e. one camper & one tent or two tents).

The campground is to be used for recreational purposes only. Conducting any business activity is prohibited.

All property including, but not limited to, satellite dishes, TV antennas, equipment, etc. must be kept within the boundaries of the campsite. Attaching equipment to any tree or landscape is prohibited.

The person registered for camping is responsible for all persons in the party.

All persons in the park shall observe the "quiet hours" from 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m., during which no unreasonable noise which disturbs the customary use of the camping areas shall be allowed.

Unreasonable noises include, but are not limited to: generators, televisions, radios, boisterous conduct, loud pets and unnecessary operation of motor-driven vehicles.

At all times, radios, televisions, and the playing of musical instruments must be kept at a sound level that does not disturb other campers. Please be courteous to other campers.

Bands or live musical performances are not allowed in the campground without prior authorization.

Fires shall be built in designated areas only.

The washing of automobiles, boats or trailers is prohibited.

Campers leaving the park must show their wristbands at the Toll House upon return.

Check-out time for the campground is 5 p.m.

OTHER INFORMATION

No ATV's allowed in the park. Motorized vehicles allowed include golf carts, scooters, and handicapped scooters. Firewood and Ice are available for purchase at the Toll House. Cutting of live trees of any size is prohibited. Gathering of deadwood is allowed in all areas EXCEPT from the Nature Trail. Showers are available for campers at the shower/ restroom facility. Security personnel patrol this park and will enforce all rules; they have been instructed to call the Indiana State Police in case of emergencies or serious problems.

ALCOHOL IS PROHIBITED FROM BEING BROUGHT INTO THE SOUTH HARRISON PARK
