Some of our past community projects include Kindergarten Round-Up (annual eye testing of Kindergartners), eye glasses for children and adults, hearing aids, gas to go to and from medical appointments, one-time utility bill assistance, wheelchair ramps, free movies in the park, scholarships, donation for playground equipment, food pantry donations, donation for shelter house in Laconia, donation for gazebo in Elizabeth, angel tree, shirts for the High School Cross Country team, Crusade for Children, service dog and more. We have assisted other community groups with their projects. We organized the Lions Clubs in Harrison County to purchase a new van for the Harrison County Veterans Van program. Our club raised \$8,700 of the \$16,000 for the first van. Our club has already raised over \$5,000 towards a second van. Approximately 1000 Harrison County Veterans utilize the van service free of charge each year according to the Harrison County Veterans Service Office.
